Fires and fireworks – Fire prevention must be the first concern of every visitor.

Possession or use of firearms or weapons.

Possession or consumption of any intoxicant.

Use of skateboards, motorized vehicles and equipment.

Wood gathering.

Domestic pets are prohibited.

This area is characterized by certain inherent dangers. These include but are not limited to: mountain lions, rattlesnakes, poison oak, poisonous insects, extremes in weather and rugged terrain. Your safety can not be guaranteed. Stay alert to potential danger.
