

Three Points to Sulphur Springs

Date: August 29, 2012

Distance: 7.5 miles RT

Elevation gain: -800 ft.

Trailhead Directions: Drive north on Hwy 2 (Angeles Crest) from the 210 freeway past the Clear Creek Information Center to Sulphur Springs Road (Three Points at mile paddle 52.85) which is about 2.5 miles past the Chilao Visitor Center turnoff. Turn left then proceed about 100 feet to the paved parking area and park. There is a restroom at the parking area.

The Hike: We will proceed west on the Silver Moccasin trail for 1.3 miles, then proceed on a private road past John Dee Lake 1.4 miles until it intersects with the Pacific Crest Trail (PCT). We will have cookies near the lake. Then we turn left and go 1.8 miles to the Sulphur Springs Campground for lunch. After lunch we will follow the PCT back to the parking area and refreshments.

Those hikers desiring a shorter hike can turn right, at the PCT junction, and proceed 1.7 miles back to the parking area for a 4.4 mile hike.

GPS Data:

RT = 7.5 mi.

Max elevation change = 760 ft.
