The Bridge to Nowhere

Mike Gessner will lead the hike for Wednesday, July 21, 1993, up the East Fork of the San Gabriel River to the Narrows and the Bridge to Nowhere. We will wade the river about 15 times in each direction, (knee-deep water), so expect to get your feet wet

This hike is about 9 miles round trip. The elevation gain is about 1000 feet. The difficulty is moderate.

From Azusa drive up the San Gabriel Canyon road, (SR-39) about 10 miles, then turn right on the East Fork road. Continue 8 more miles to the parking area at the end of the road. Allow 30 minutes driving time above Azusa.

Please arrive at the trailhead by 8:15 AM. We will start the hike at 8:30 AM. This is our summer schedule.
