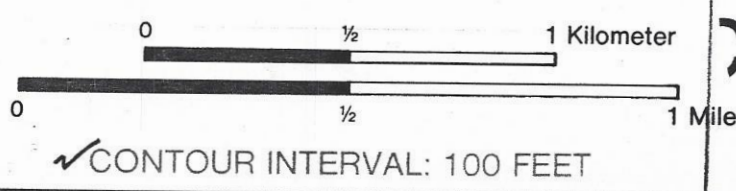
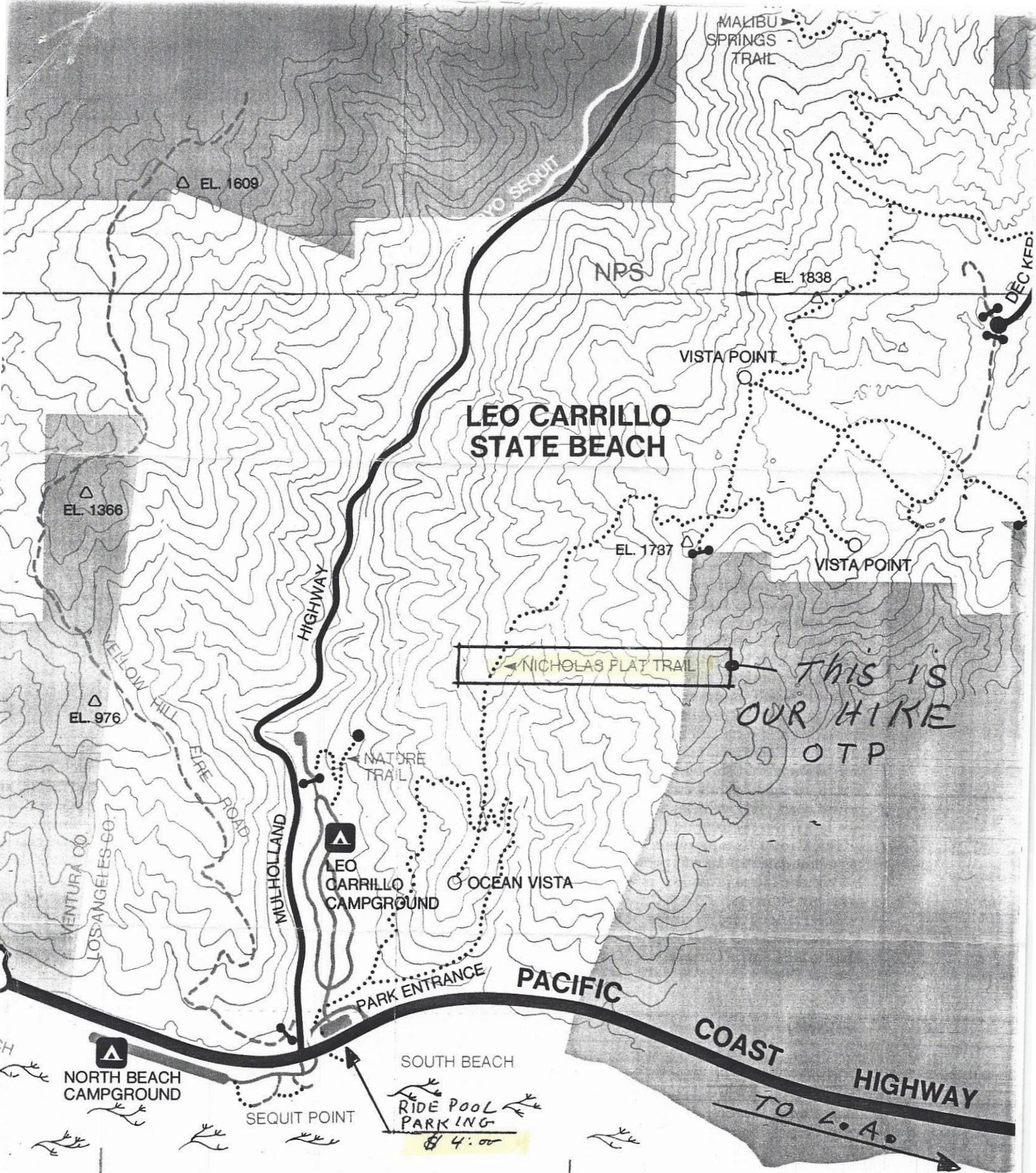
H I K I N G

Hikers can explore the Yellow Hill Fire Trail and the NICHOLAS FLAT TRAIL. The Nicholas Flat Trail is recommended for more experienced hikers. The steep trail meanders through the various plant communities of the Santa Monica Mountains.

The birds and wildflowers encountered along the way as well as the pond found in the Nicholas Flat area make the hike worthwhile. On warm days, carry plenty of water.

On a clear day, Anacapa & Santa Cruz, the closest of the Channel Islands, are visible from the trail. In the months of May & June, look for the yellow flower of the prickly pear cactus.
