Subject: OTP Hike for 6 September 2000

Dear Hikers,

The hike is Red Box to Mt. Wilson via Rattlesnake Trail, 6.6 miles with a 2200 ft climb to Mt. Wilson with a ride back to Red Box for refreshments. It sounds bad but we are in the shade for most all of the hike because we are on the north side of the mountain with lots of trees.

Another choice to shorten the hike is to turn-around at Valley Forge Camp Ground to return directly to Red Box rather than proceed with the group up to Mt. Wilson. This hike is 4.6 miles round-trip with only a 1000 ft. climb back up the way we came.

Hand-outs will be provided at the 30 August hike as I'm not planning to attend Mike Guessner's hike tomorrow. I apologize for breaking my "Bear Creek" record but we have been there too recently. This hike was stolen from Jim Spotts originally in June 1995.
