To Magic Mountain Relay Installations

Feb. 6

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14.5 miles round trip

Elevation gain: 1400' to 1500'

I WANT EVERYONE TO GET TO THE INSTALLATIONS TO SEE THE WONDERFUL VISTAS AND WILL DO WHATEVER IS NECESSARY TO ACCOMMODATE YOU.

MAIN HIKE: We will start at 9 A.M. from Bear Divide Vista on Little Tujunga Canyon Road.

Secondary hike: Begins at 9:30 2.5 miles from above on Santa Clara Divide Road.

For the 3rd hike we will drive hikers to the base of the installations and they can walk back downhill.

Getting there: From the 210 freeway take the Osborne exit. Turn north. At the 2nd light turn left onto Osborne following the Wildlife Waystation signs. Osborne becomes Little Tujunga Road. Drive 11.1 miles to Bear Divide Vista where the first hikers park.

Others negotiate the sharp right bend (100 yds.) and take Santa Clara Divide Rd.-2N17- on the right. (If you go downhill, you have missed it!) Drive 2.5 miles to a spot where there is a pine grove on the left side of the road and ample parking across from it on the right. The road immediately starts DOWNHILL. From here the hike is 10 miles rt. and about 800' elevation gain.

Groups 1 & 2 will join for lunch at Magic Mountain summit. All will have enjoyed the 360-degree view with 40 to 50 mile visibility to the North. Easily identifiable are Mt. Gleason, Iron Mt., Mendenhall Peak and the Tehachapis. In case of recent rain expect some snow and a cool breeze.

Refreshments follow at Bear Divide Vista picnic area.
